Mr. Tucker has been a life member of the PVA for 34 years. He was appointed to the Board of Directors as Volunteer Liaison Officer (VLO) for the Long Beach Chapter in 1977 and for the Bay Area & Western (BAW) Chapter 1984-1985. In 1986, he became a National Service Officer (NSO) representing National PVA, working in VA hospitals throughout the Bay Area. In 1987, he transferred to Richmond as a NSO to work in the Richmond and Hampton VAs. In 1990, he volunteered for the Virginia Chapter as Sports Coordinator and Advocacy & Legislative representative, also assisting with fundraising and participating as a member of their budget committee.

In 2000, Mr. Tucker worked with Angel Nunez and Jim Griffith for the BAW Chapter. He is a former National Director for the BAW Chapter as well as a past President of the State Commanders Veterans Council (2011). He previously worked with Dave Hollingshead on Advocacy & Legislation and is still actively involved at the capital representing the chapter. He was also formerly appointed on the Field Advisory Committee by the National Office and is currently serving as the Government Relations Director.

Mr. Tucker graduated from Army Navy Academy in 1971 and graduated from New Mexico Military Institute in 1973. In that same year, he also attended New Mexico State University majoring in Police Science, in which he also attended University of California. He retired from the army in January 1977.
